

DIRECTIONS FOR USING THE ONLINE BOOKS

*We use one textbook in class but several other can be used as reference books*and they can all be found on line at this site:*

select "student"

then select "Michigan" from the pull down menu

Scroll down to "Earth Science" section

*Select "**I: The Air Around You c 2002**"*

(This is the book we are currently using. I will update the students if we use the other books. The process will be the same, just different user names and passwords.)

Place your cursor over "Online Student Edition"

Then select "Full Versions"

*The User Name is **AAY***

*The password is **ChA7UB9S5e***

BOTH are case sensitive!

On the left side of this page in the bookmarks column you'll see "Glencoe Earth Science".

Then select "Module I: The Air Around You"

Then "Table of Contents"

From there you can navigate through each chapter and its materials using the bookmarks column on the left side of the page.
